The Healthy Opportunities Pilot (HOP) is a state and federally funded program to help improve the overall health of qualifying Medicaid members and improve healthcare costs.

Do You Qualify? *

To potentially qualify for Healthy Opportunities Pilot services, you must be in a select Medicaid program, live in one of the pilot counties, have qualifying health need and a food, transportation, housing and/or safety need.

What We Offer:

If you struggle having enough food, safe or affordable housing, have problems driving or finding a ride, or feeling safe you may qualify for the Healthy Opportunities Pilot. Services are offered in:

- Food
- Transportation
- Housing
- Interpersonal Safety
