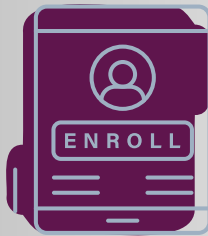
LINC Anatomy Update:

97 Residents have enrolled to become Peer Support Specialists, and 170 people have enrolled to become Community Health Workers through the LINC Anatomy Program!

This program allows residents to receive funding to become a PSS/CHW and be able to help others who are going through the reentry process once they graduate!

- The most popular second-chance job received by discharged clients was was restaurant/food worker (58.2%) and the second-most was construction/extraction/machinery (8.4%)
- 89.6% of all clients have been connected with housing
- 50% of all clients have been connected with employment

48 clients are currently active



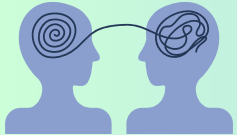
NC Fit is expanding! LINC will now offer not only NC-Fit and NC-Fit Recovery services, but will also now be offering NC-Fit Wellness programming for clients with SPMI or SMI's in the new year! We have signed up 5 clients for this program so far!



Cognitive Behavioral Interventions (CBI) Group



241 Clients have participated



Client's moods increased an average of 21.37% per session



91.5% of clients self-reported having a history of substance use



11 sessions held in January

All clients throughout the month of January seemed motivated to start the year off right. With all group members showing up and being "extremely supportive and encouraging with their peers during the group". Overall, average check-in AND check-out rankings were higher amongst the groups this month, illustrating a desire to start the new year with mindsets that will help to continue to uplift and benefit them moving forward.
